

WELCOME NEW KARTER

Oakleigh kart track is situated only 25 Km from the Melbourne CBD, on the South Eastern side of the city. The club has been established for over 25 years and in that time many changes to the facility have taken place.

The club now has a circuit over 900 metres in length as well as modern up to date facilities with licenced clubrooms and seating for up to 120, as well as a fully equipped kitchen to cater for members and their quests at club events.

Combine this with other features such as track lighting for night events, 3 story starters control tower and a 2 story race control then add to this a circuit design that is both demanding on drivers skills and set-up. Oakleigh is a hard circuit to master but once mastered allows the driver to gain the level of experience required for most other tracks. We have produced a number of National and State Champions who have gained their skills at Oakleigh.

The Committee and its helpers are working tirelessly to ensure that the facilities at the Oakeligh Go-Kart Racing Club are at the forefront of karting in Australia. Constant improvements and developments to many facets of the club's infrastructure and grounds are ensuring that the karters and spectators experience is of the highest level. Over \$400,000 have been spent in recent times on numerous improvements.

Our latest major project has just been completed with our entire grid being covered along with a new grid marshall's office. Our toilet / shower block are second to none and a pleasure to use. The club is also investigating some form of undercover pitting facility for all competitors.

We have just upgraded to the latest technologies for our AMB timing system. Each club day and open race we utilize a transponder system for lap scoring and timing. The results of the race event are then posted on the http://ogkrc.mylaps.com website for competitors, sponsors and interested parties to view. For those competitors who choose to purchase their own transponders, they can also access all of their laptimes for the race event. We will soon be implementing the next phase of this upgrade which will allow karters with personal transponders to use them any time they are practising at the Oakleigh track.

Racing at the club consists of 10 Club Race days - Held on the last Sunday of every month- and 3 to 4 Open Race Meetings throughout the Year. Club Day's attract about 150 entries with most classes being catered for.

Practice at the Club is restricted to club members only, they are issued with a key to allow them access into the track for practice any day of the week. the track is made available for Non Oakleigh members leading up to Open Race Meetings.

Licencing

All Karters must belong to a club and apply through the club for a licence. The first three race meetings you attend will be Club Days where you will run on a "P" plate from the rear of the field. At Oakleigh Club Days, where enough "P" plate drivers enter a class, we will run a "P" plate race, allowing you to compete in a race environment against other karters of similar experience. After the successful completion of three meetings on "P" plates and a meeting where you act as a flag marshall, you will be eligible for a "C" grade race licence. This will allow you to compete at events at Oakleigh and at Open Meetings where you will qualify for a "B" grade licence. This then allows you to compete at State and National Title events.

Club days

Where you will start racing, these are held on the last Sunday of each month except December and January. Check out our website www.ogkrc.com.au for details of how to enter and what to expect. Remember, if you need help – ask!

Classes

Midgets and Rookies comprise drivers aged from 7 to 12 years and are aimed at teaching young racers to drive karts with restricted performance and low cost and develop their skills so they can progress to......

Juniors Aged 12 to 16 years, Junior classes comprise "Junior National" using Yamaha "J" engines, or the more powerful "Junior Clubman" class. National classes use reliable 100cc Yamaha engines that need infrequent rebuilds and tyres that last a season to

keep costs down and allow drivers to develop skills without the technical demands of Open classes. Light and heavy divisions are available to provide an opportunity for all drivers. Junior Clubman is a higher performance class for "B" grade licence holders, using Yamaha KT100S or water-cooled ARC engines and is a natural progression for developing Junior karters

Seniors Aged 16 years plus – National classes, again using Yamaha "J" engines and restricted tyres, Senior National is economical and an ideal starting ground for new, senior karters.

Clubman Classes, similar to Senior National, but using the Yamaha KT100S engine, Clubman classes provide faster racing and larger, more competitive fields. Clubman classes provide three weight categories, assuring racing for everyone, as well as an Over 40's class for the "senior" senior competitor.

Rotax and Leopard classes. With electric starting and water cooled engines, these are the elite classes of karting. Fast and powerful, they are always well represented at Oakleigh and provide spectacular and exciting racing.
